

## Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. High School "Non-Negotiables"

- 1. Teach from Bell-to-Bell. This means you should differentiate your instruction by using *various methods and activities* to meet the needs of all learners).
- 2. Use *formative assessments/assessment for learning* strategies to know student progress and drive your instructional strategies.
- 3. Use *data* from formative assessments to differentiate instruction for those students not meeting standards and those exceeding standards.
- 4. Stand at the door during the changing of all class/Be visible and vocal! Monitor and move students along in the hallways.
- 5. Limit restroom passes (4 per semester per student) Use professional discretion!
- 6. No passes during the first and last 15 minutes of each class (15 Minute Rule!)
- 7. Sign In/Out in the Main Office Teacher Workroom (everyday).
- 8. Arrive on time for work (7:45 AM) and for all duties throughout the day
- 9. If an absence is imminent, please contact your Grade Level Administrator and fill out the appropriate leave form.
- 10. Update all student grades in a timely manner. At least three grades must be entered weekly.
- 11. Post attendance <u>each</u> period on Infinite Campus. This <u>must</u> be done the <u>first 10 minutes</u> of <u>each</u> class period!
- 12. Maintain accurate and complete records.
- 13. Submit documents, grades, and reports on time.
- 14. Model the behaviors and language you expect from your students.
- 15. All communication (i.e. emails, telephone calls and/or request) must returned within 48 hours.
